Dear Sir,

I have read your interview with Usayd Younis about his Satpal Ram film. I have not seen the entire film, only a trailer, but I have read reviews of it and the directors' own comments. The bottom line is that this film is a tissue of lies and they have fooled you. Most of the people Mr Ram and his supporters fool are complicit in their own deception. Hopefully you will not be.

I set up a website about the murder of Clarke Pearce in 2001; I have made four major updates to it over the years. The third major update was made in 2016 when the legal papers were released under the 30 year rule. The fourth major update was last month, specifically to counter the latest tranche of lies, which are far from new.

Briefly, in reference to your interview, it was Ram, not Clarke who alluded to "Paki music", and according to the witness statement of Abdul Mozomil, it was Ram and his chum Shinji who had been abusive to the waiters previously.

Ram murdered Pearce with a flick knife – an illegal weapon – stabbing him in the back twice. Often they claim Ram was attacked by six white men and that Clarke died only because he refused to be treated by a woman doctor. The reality is there were only three white men in Clarke's party; the three women included his fiancée and his sister. And he did not refuse to be treated by a woman doctor, at least not according to the woman doctor in question.

Ram's claim of self-defence is as delusional as Karmelo Anthony's claim – the teenager who is just starting a life sentence for murdering another (unarmed) teen.

Ram was advised that his only chance of a partial defence was provocation; he accepted that advice.

The restaurant staff were not witnesses to “racism”, they were prosecution witnesses.

Ram was actually paroled in 2002 but was recalled to prison following allegations of assault and criminal damage. His undoubted suffering had nothing to do with race, rather he was the author of his own misfortune.

As for the alleged brutality of his gaolers, there are many thousands of Asian inmates in Britain’s prisons along with many other minorities. Very few of them claim to have been victimised by prison staff. Why do you think that is?

Over the years I have written to many left wing publications about this case. The only positive response was from TRIBUNE which published my letter on July 12, 2002. An Indian newspaper also called TRIBUNE (of Chandigarh) published a letter of mine in full on October 24, 2001.
